BAUTISMOS - Los padres de familia tienen que estar registrados en la parroquia y deben asistir fielmente a la Misa; Los padrinos deben de ser Católicos bautizados que hayan recibido el Sacramento de la Primera Comunión y Confirmación, que estén viviendo una vida honesta, y ser mayores de 16 años.

Cada niño necesita por lo menos un padrino o madrina. Si tiene dos padrinos, tiene que ser un hombre y una mujer. Si están casados, deben estar casados por la Iglesia Católica, asistir regularmente a la Santa Misa del Domingo, y que estén viviendo su fe. Los padrinos no necesitan ser pareja. Si los padrinos son solteros, deben estar viviendo una vida honesta y casta (continencia, pureza). Las personas que viven con una pareja fuera del matrimonio no son elegibles para ser padrinos.

MATRIMONIO - La Pareja debe tener una reunión con el sacerdote por lo menos seis meses antes de programar la boda. Por lo menos una persona debe estar registrada y estar practicando su fe.

PASTOR'S NOTE

Greetings in the Lord Jesus Christ! In this weekend's Gospel reading, Jesus is asleep on the boat while the storms rage around him. If we have storms raging around us, it can seem that God doesn't care, or that He's asleep and doesn't hear us. But He is there. Perhaps that is all we need to know. Would He allow the boat to sink if He is on it? So, why be terrified? The boat is also symbolic of the church. Despite the onslaught of the chaotic world, we are safe in the boat because Jesus is there. Jesus is king of heaven and earth. He is God and God created the world. Therefore, He has control even over the chaos. Let us be in awe that it is He whom even wind and sea obey!

We are unsafe, however, from the storms, the temptations, the chaos in the world, if we do not remain in the boat, if we do not remain in the Catholic Church, if we do not obey the Lord. Jesus founded His church and gave her authority to set the rules. One of the main rules for us is for our own good, that we have an obligation to go to Mass every Sunday. Knowing our weaknesses, if we did not have this obligation, we would fall away. So here is a reminder of our obligation to go to Mass. Obedience is a virtue.

Is Missing Sunday Mass a Mortal Sin?

"Missing Sunday Mass is a serious sin because you are putting something else at a higher priority than God. This is always the case unless you are physically unable to attend (e.g., illness, no transportation...).

If missing Mass involves full knowledge and full consent (basically you know you should go but choose not to), then it is a mortal sin.

For a sin to be a mortal sin, three conditions must be met:

1. Grave Offense – it's seriously wrong,
2. Full Knowledge – I fully know it's wrong, and
3. Full Consent – I freely choose to do it.

To attend Mass is a privilege, and any and all Catholics should want to attend Mass. The ability to receive Jesus in the Eucharist on Sunday at Mass, is the greatest gift Jesus gave us on Earth. We should be excited to attend Mass to worship God and to receive the Eucharist.

Lastly, if someone intentionally misses Mass on Sunday or a Holy Day of Obligation, then he/she should not receive Holy Communion until he/she goes to Confession. The reason for this is because we can never receive the Body and Blood of Christ in a state of mortal sin. And to receive the Eucharist in a state of mortal sin is a mortal sin."

The turtle freaks out even more and bites at the tentacles as a warning. Now both are reacting with the Octopus forcefully reaching for connection and the turtle equally forcefully retreating. 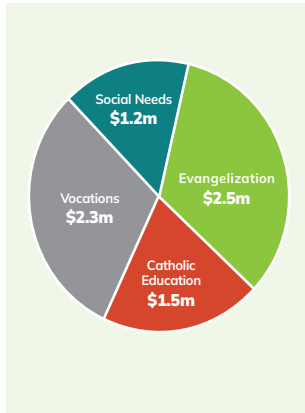
Vocations: Through continued efforts in evangelization, our diocese is blessed to be experiencing increased awareness and interest in vocations.

NOTA del PÁRROCO

¡Saludos en el Señor Jesucristo! En la lectura del Evangelio de este fin de semana, Jesús está dormido en el barco mientras las tormentas azotan a su alrededor. Si tenemos tormentas a nuestro alrededor, puede parecer que a Dios no le importa, o que está dormido y no nos escucha. Pero Él está ahí. Quizás eso sea todo lo que necesitamos saber. ¿Permitiría que el barco se hundiera si él estuviera en él? Entonces, ¿por qué estar aterrizado? El barco también es un símbolo de la iglesia. A pesar de los embates del mundo caótico, estamos seguros en la barca porque Jesús está allí. Jesús es el rey del cielo y de la tierra. Él es Dios y Dios creó el mundo. Por lo tanto, Él tiene control incluso sobre el caos. ¡Estemos asombrados de que es Él a quien hasta el viento y el mar obedecen!

Sin embargo, no estamos seguros de las tormentas, las tentaciones, el caos del mundo, si no permanecemos en la barca, si no permanecemos en la Iglesia católica, si no obedecemos al Señor. Jesús fundó su iglesia y dió autoridad para establecer las reglas. Una de las reglas principales para nosotros es, por nuestro propio bien, que tenemos la obligación de ir a Misa todos los domingos. Conociendo nuestras debilidades, si no tuviéramos esta obligación, caeríamos. Así que aquí hay un recordatorio de nuestra obligación de ir a Misa. La obediencia es una virtud.

¿Faltar a la Misa dominical es pecado mortal?

"Faltar a la Misa dominical es un pecado grave porque estás poniendo algo más en prioridad que Dios. Este es siempre el caso a menos que usted no pueda asistir físicamente (por ejemplo, enfermedad, falta de transporte...).

Si faltar a Misa implica pleno conocimiento y pleno consentimiento (básicamente sabes que debes ir pero eliges no hacerlo), entonces es un pecado mortal.

Para que un pecado sea mortal se deben cumplir tres condiciones:

1. Ofensa grave: está muy mal,
2. Conocimiento total: sé perfectamente que está mal y
3. Consentimiento total: elijo hacerlo libremente.

Asistir a Misa es un privilegio, y todos los católicos deberían querer asistir a Misa. La capacidad de recibir a Jesús en la Eucaristía el domingo en la Misa es el regalo más grande que Jesús nos dio en la Tierra. Deberíamos estar emocionados de asistir a Misa para adorar a Dios y recibir la Eucaristía.

Por último, si alguien intencionalmente falta a Misa el domingo o un día santo de precepto, entonces no debe recibir la Sagrada Comunión hasta que se confiese.

La razón de esto es que nunca podremos recibir el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo en estado de pecado mortal. Y recibir la Eucaristía en estado de pecado mortal es pecado mortal".
