BAUTISMOS - Los padres de familia tienen que estar registrados en la parroquia y deben asistir fielmente a la Misa; Los padrinos deben de ser Católicos bautizados que hayan recibido el Sacramento de la Primera Comunión y Confirmación, que estén viviendo una vida honesta, y ser mayores de 16 años.

Cada niño necesita por lo menos un padrino o madrina. Si tiene dos padrinos, tiene que ser un hombre y una mujer. Si están casados, deben estar casados por la Iglesia Católica, asistir regularmente a la Santa Misa del Domingo, y que estén viviendo su fe. Los padrinos no necesitan ser pareja. Si los padrinos son solteros, deben estar viviendo una vida honesta y casta (continencia, pureza). Las personas que viven con una pareja fuera del matrimonio no son elegibles para ser padrinos.

MATRIMONIO - La Pareja debe tener una reunión con el sacerdote por lo menos seis meses antes de programar la boda. Por lo menos una persona debe estar registrada y estar practicando su fe.

SUNDAY, JUNE 30, 2024**THIRTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME****PASTOR'S NOTE**

Greetings in the Lord, Jesus Christ! This weekend, we hear of the power of the physical presence of Jesus. The young girl of 12 is dying, but at the pleading of her father, Jesus goes to her. By the time He gets there, she has already died, yet, He goes in to raise her from the dead even as the people ridicule Him for saying she is only asleep. He takes her by the hand and tells her to arise. She comes back to life, walks around, and eats. The woman suffering from a hemorrhage for 12 years is so desperate for a cure that she believes she will be healed if she only touches the cloak of Jesus. She touches His clothes, power goes out from Jesus, and she is healed. In both cases, it was the physical presence of Jesus – the woman touches just the clothes of Jesus and Jesus touches the little girl – that brings healing and life. This is why our Catholic faith is so powerful, because we have the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, so real that when we receive Him in the Eucharist, He transforms us to become more like Him. So real that when we sit in His presence in church, even if He is hidden in the tabernacle, the power of His presence reaches out to us and changes us and gives us His peace, healing, and love.

This is why we have such reverence and awe for the Lord Jesus Christ that when we enter His presence, especially during our worship of Him at Mass, we come trembling, afraid to offend His majesty. This is why some people who feel they are great sinners might be afraid to enter the church. Their instincts tend toward Simon Peter falling at the knees of Jesus saying, "Depart from me Lord, for I am a sinner." (Luke 5:8) Surely, the unholy should not mix with the holy. Jesus says however, "I have not come to call the righteous to repentance but sinners." (Luke 5:32) The church is for the sinner.

Nevertheless, He is still the King and the Mass is the wedding banquet. Those who enter must have some measure of decorum for the wedding feast, lest the King say, "My friend, how is it that you came in here without a wedding garment?" and say to his attendants, "Bind his hands and feet, and cast him into the darkness outside, where there will be wailing and grinding of teeth." (Matthew 22:12-13) This parable regards our preparation for heaven, but it also regards our attitude towards God. What are we saying to God if we wear T-shirts and shorts to Mass? What are we saying to God if we show up late to Mass and then try to receive Communion? Jesus is abundantly merciful, but only in the measure that we desire His mercy. By their fruits, you will know them, says Jesus. By our fruits, we will know ourselves and what might need to change (if we bear bad fruit). Whoever remains in the Lord Jesus will bear much fruit. May you bear abundantly good fruit! And may the presence of the Lord in your life bring you His peace, healing, and love!

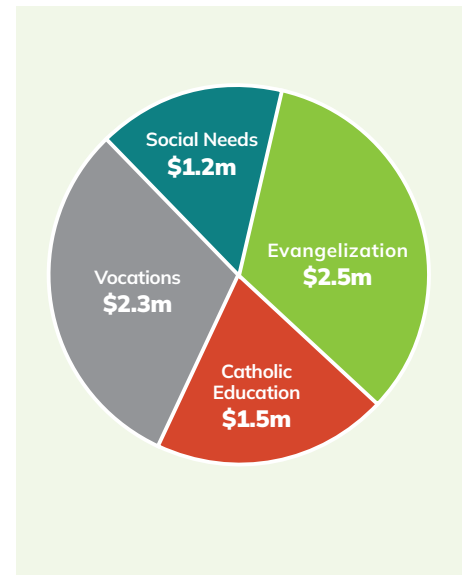
Vocations: Through continued efforts in evangelization, our diocese is blessed to be experiencing increased awareness and interest in vocations.

NOTA del PÁRROCO

¡Saludos en el Señor Jesucristo! Este fin de semana escuchamos sobre el poder de la presencia física de Jesús. La niña de 12 años está muriendo, pero ante la súplica de su padre, Jesús acude a ella. Cuando llega allí, ella ya ha muerto, sin embargo, él entra para resucitarla de entre los muertos incluso cuando la gente lo ridiculiza por decir que ella solo está dormida. Él la toma de la mano y le dice que se levante. Ella vuelve a la vida, camina y come. La mujer que sufre una hemorragia desde hace 12 años está tan desesperada por una cura que cree que será curada con sólo tocar el manto de Jesús. Ella toca sus ropas, sale poder de Jesús y ella queda sana. En ambos casos, fue la presencia física de Jesús (la mujer toca sólo la ropa de Jesús y Jesús toca a la niña) lo que trae sanación y vida. Por eso nuestra fe católica es tan poderosa, porque tenemos la Presencia Real de Jesús en la Eucaristía, tan real que cuando lo recibimos en la Eucaristía, él nos transforma para llegar a ser más como él. Tan real que cuando nos sentamos en Su presencia en la iglesia, incluso si Él está escondido en el tabernáculo, el poder de Su presencia nos alcanza, nos cambia y nos da Su paz, sanidad y amor.

Es por eso que tenemos tal reverencia y asombro por el Señor Jesucristo que cuando entramos en Su presencia, especialmente durante nuestra adoración a Él en la Misa, venimos temblando, temerosos de ofender Su majestad. Esta es la razón por la que algunas personas que se sienten grandes pecadores pueden tener miedo de entrar a la iglesia. Sus instintos tienden a que Simón Pedro caiga de rodillas ante Jesús y le diga: "Apártate de mí, Señor, porque soy pecador" (Lucas 5:8). Seguramente lo impío no debería mezclarse con lo santo. Sin embargo, Jesús dice: "No he venido a llamar a justos al arrepentimiento, sino a pecadores" (Lucas 5:32). La iglesia es para el pecador.

Sin embargo, Él sigue siendo el Rey y la Misa es el banquete de bodas. Los que entren deben tener cierta medida de decoro para el banquete de bodas, no sea que el Rey diga: "Amigo mío, ¿cómo es que entraste aquí sin vestido de boda?" y diga a sus servidores: "Aten sus manos y sus pies, y arrojenlo afuera, en las tinieblas, donde será el llanto y el cruji de dientes" (Mateo 22:12-13). Esta parábola se refiere a nuestra preparación para el cielo, pero también a nuestra actitud hacia Dios. ¿Qué le estamos diciendo a Dios si vamos en camiseta y pantalón corto a Misa? ¿Qué le estamos diciendo a Dios si llegamos tarde a Misa y luego intentamos recibir la comunión? Jesús es abundantemente misericordioso, pero sólo en la medida en que deseamos su misericordia. Por sus frutos los conoceréis, dice Jesús. Por nuestros frutos, nos conoceremos a nosotros mismos y conoceremos lo que podríamos necesitar cambiar (si damos malos frutos). El que permanece en el Señor Jesús dará mucho fruto. ¡Que des abundantes buenos frutos! ¡Y que la presencia del Señor en tu vida te traiga Su paz, sanación y amor!
