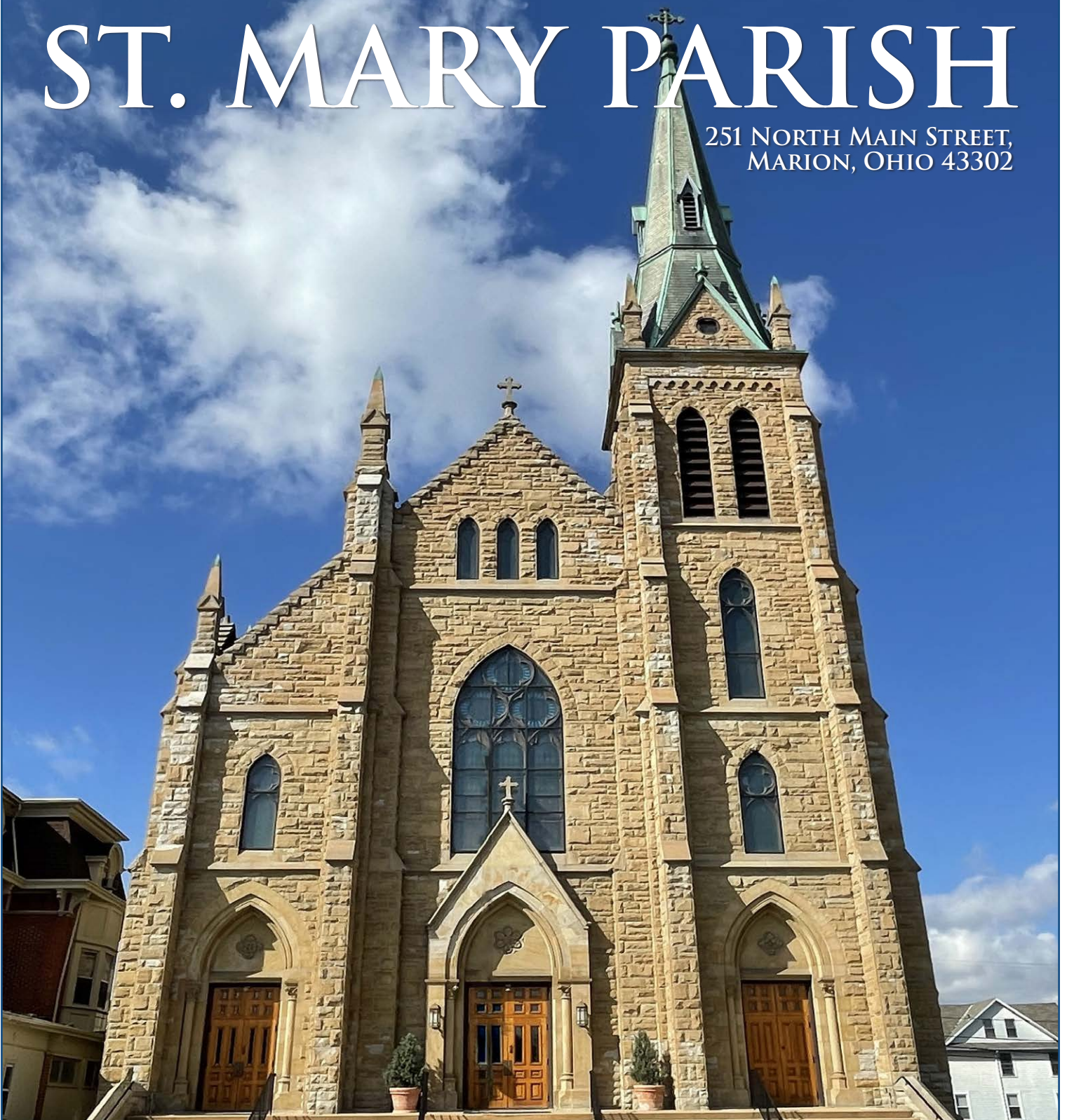

SEVENTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

PASTOR'S NOTE

Greetings in the Lord Jesus Christ! Beginning this Sunday and continuing in all the Sundays in August, we will hear from John's Gospel, chapter 6, the Bread of Life discourse. It is Jesus telling us that He is the living bread from heaven, that "whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world." Many could not fathom what He was saying about eating His flesh and drinking His blood in order to have eternal life, so they walked away and no longer followed Him. This teaching on the Eucharist was difficult for them to accept, which is all the more reason why it is true. Jesus did not go after them to say that they must have misunderstood. He kept repeating it and allowed them to walk away if they could not accept it.

Just as Jesus asked the Twelve, "Do you also want to leave?" He asks the same question to us. What do you really believe? Are you convinced? Is the Eucharist just a symbol or is it really the flesh and blood of Jesus Christ? Is He not God, capable of transforming bread and wine into His body and blood? Is He not capable of giving us His flesh and blood to eat? Perhaps it is too unfathomable for us to grasp, that God loves us so much that He would do this for us. How beautiful it is then to declare with faith like Simon Peter who answered Him, "Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We have come to believe and are convinced that you are the Holy One of God."

Just a friendly reminder that there is a Flocknote group called, "Funeral Notifications," which is in the groups in the left-hand column. If you wish to receive notifications when we have a parish funeral, join that group and you will receive notifications a few days ahead of time when we send out the note.

There is a monthly envelope that was called, "Altar Care," which was primarily for altar candles. However, we added "and Flowers" to it, so that you may use that envelope to contribute for the flowers in the sanctuary. I am grateful to the Garden Guild volunteers who contribute their own flowers, time, and effort to making the sanctuary look beautiful (and the outside grounds as well!). During the off-season, the flowers need to be purchased, so that envelope will help those who want to specifically donate for flowers.

Hello parishioners of St. Mary Parish! I'm Father Daniel Colby, your new parochial vicar, who will be arriving the weekend of July 27-28. I look forward to serving this community for the next few years. I served here as a seminarian from 2021-2022, so I know several of you already.

A little about myself. I was raised in Raleigh, North Carolina as a Presbyterian with my parents and three younger brothers. I went to Virginia Tech (Go Hokies!) and graduated in 2013 with a degree in Product Design. I moved to Columbus in 2014 for work, and had a conversion to the Catholic faith after I learned my dad was entering the Church. I entered RCIA, and was received at the Easter Vigil in 2016. Within RCIA, I first felt the calling to the priesthood, and after entering the Church, I began seminary at the Josephinum for the Diocese of Columbus in 2017. After two years of philosophy, four years of theology, and a pastoral year here with you all, I was ordained on May 18th of this year. I'm just returning from a summer of Spanish immersion at a parish in Oakland, California.

I look forward to serving you at the altar and in the confessional and visiting all the ministries here, especially the school, the Knights, and Saint Vincent de Paul. I will also be working in prison ministry up at Marion Correctional.

I hope to see old friends and new faces in the next few weeks as I get settled here. Please introduce yourself when you see me if I've not gotten to meet you yet.

Dear St. Mary Parishioners,

Having just ended the first half of our year on June 30, we would like to let you know where we stand. As of June 30, 2024, The Pantry served 5,280 people as opposed to 4,394 for the same period last year. This is an increase of

886 people or plus 20.2 % over last year.

The second half of the year is always busier so we anticipate serving between 14,000 and 15,000 people during the year. Considering that in 2022, we served 7,022 people and in 2023, we served 10,355 people, the need for assistance continues to grow. You, as parishioners of St. Mary Church, make all the difference by your generous donations and your continued support of our mission here at St. Vincent de Paul Center.

We ask for your continued support and always welcome people interested in volunteering. The need for volunteers also continues to grow, so please let us know if you are interested.

COMUNIDAD HISPANA

Saludos en el Señor Jesucristo! A partir de este domingo y continuando todos los domingos de agosto, escucharemos del Evangelio de Juan, capítulo 6, el discurso del Pan de Vida. Es Jesús diciéndonos que Él es el pan vivo del cielo, que “el que come éste pan vivirá para siempre; y el pan que daré es mi carne para la vida del mundo.” Muchos no podían entender lo que decía acerca de comer su carne y beber su sangre para tener vida eterna, así que se alejaron y ya no lo siguieron. Esta enseñanza sobre la Eucaristía les resultó difícil de aceptar, lo que con mayor razón es cierta. Jesús no fue tras ellos para decirles que debían haber entendido mal. Siguió repitiéndolo y les permitió irse si no podían aceptarlo.

Así como Jesús preguntó a los Doce: “¿También vosotros queréis irnos?”, a nosotros nos hace la misma pregunta. ¿Qué crees realmente? ¿Estás convencido? ¿Es la Eucaristía sólo un símbolo o es realmente la carne y la sangre de Jesucristo? ¿No es Dios, capaz de transformar el pan y el vino en su cuerpo y su sangre? ¿No es capaz de darnos a comer su carne y su sangre? Quizás sea demasiado insondable para que podamos comprender que Dios nos ama tanto que haría esto por nosotros. Qué hermoso es entonces declarar con fe como Simón Pedro que le respondió: “Maestro, ¿a quién iremos? Tú tienes palabras de vida eterna. Hemos creído y estamos convencidos de que tú eres el Santo de Dios. “

Solo un recordatorio amistoso de que hay un grupo Flocknote llamado “Notificaciones de funerales” que se encuentra en los grupos de la columna de la izquierda. Si desea recibir notificaciones cuando tengamos un funeral parroquial, únase a ese grupo y recibirá notificaciones con unos días de anticipación cuando enviemos la nota.
