BAUTISMOS - Los padres de familia tienen que estar registrados en la parroquia y deben asistir fielmente a la Misa; Los padrinos deben de ser Católicos bautizados que hayan recibido el Sacramento de la Primera Comunión y Confirmación, que estén viviendo una vida honesta, y ser mayores de 16 años.

Cada niño necesita por lo menos un padrino o madrina. Si tiene dos padrinos, tiene que ser un hombre y una mujer. Si están casados, deben estar casados por la Iglesia Católica, asistir regularmente a la Santa Misa del Domingo, y que estén viviendo su fe. Los padrinos no necesitan ser pareja. Si los padrinos son solteros, deben estar viviendo una vida honesta y casta (continencia, pureza). Las personas que viven con una pareja fuera del matrimonio no son elegibles para ser padrinos.

MATRIMONIO - La Pareja debe tener una reunión con el sacerdote por lo menos seis meses antes de programar la boda. Por lo menos una persona debe estar registrada y estar practicando su fe.

PASTOR'S NOTE

Greetings in the Lord, Jesus Christ! Thank you to all those who have asked for clarification in my recent Pastor's Notes. Regarding mortal sin in the June 23rd bulletin, it is necessary to confess mortal sins in order to receive absolution in the Sacrament of Confession. If one is conscious of a mortal sin, but chooses not to confess it, then one might not be absolved even if the priest says the absolution prayer. If one has grave fear of confessing a mortal sin, then their culpability might be lessened. Please know that the priests are not there to judge anyone afterward. We do not want to remember anyone's sins. That would be like trying to find delight in other peoples' trash. There are so many good things to appreciate in people, why would we want to focus on their trash? If one has a mortal sin that they forget to confess, but remember later, then they should confess it at their next Confession, but they are absolved of their sins in the current Confession.

And since we are speaking of Confession, all Catholics have an obligation to go to Confession at least once a year. Speaking of once a year, Catholics are only obligated to receive Communion once a year, and that would be during the Easter season. We must go to Mass every Sunday (the Saturday vigil counts. And again, those who are physically unable to, have no transportation, have to care for a sick loved one, etc. are not under the obligation), but we do not have an obligation to receive Communion at every Mass. If someone cannot make it to Sunday Mass due to work or the like, they could perhaps consider going to a weekday Mass. Some find a Sunday evening Mass elsewhere. Some Hispanics go to the English Masses and some non-Hispanics go to the Spanish Mass even if they cannot understand the language.

Regarding the note in the June 30th bulletin of being late for Mass and not receiving Communion, there is no hard rule about what's considered "late for Mass." For me personally, if I miss the "Confiteor" ("I confess to Almighty God...") out of negligence then I would consider myself late for Mass. However, if I am stopped by a train and not late due to negligence, I could recall my sins and say the Act of Contrition while waiting. If I miss the first reading, then I would still attend, but not receive. Those with children who can't find their shoes might be excused. The Lord is kind and merciful!

There are many who do not receive Communion at Mass: those who are not yet Catholic, those who have not yet received First Communion, those in mortal sin. It is always praiseworthy to see the non-Catholics at a funeral Mass who simply remain in their pews during Communion or make the sign of the cross over themselves so as to signal in a quiet manner their respect for the Eucharist and to receive a blessing from the priest instead.

Finally, while I am at it, last week I gave some questions for reflection about what our attitude toward God is based on how we dress at Mass, or if we are late due to negligence. Another thing that occurred to me is leaving immediately after receiving Communion (those who leave for serious reasons would be exempt). Do we treat the Eucharist as a superstitious magic pill that we think will work if we receive it and walk straight out the door? Here's a story about the humorous St. Philip Neri from the 16th century: Philip became a priest and, during Mass, noticed that one member of his congregation would always leave straight after receiving Holy Communion.

One time, as the parishioner left the church, Philip sent two altar servers, both bearing candles, to follow the man and escort him through the streets. This was accompanied also, no doubt, by much laughing and pointing by those they passed!

Irritated, the man demanded to know why the acolytes were following him. They said that Fr. Neri had instructed them to do so. On hearing this, the man then went back to the church and asked the priest why he had done this. Saint Philip said:

"It is to pay proper respect to Our Lord, whom you are carrying away with you. Since you neglect to adore Him, I sent the servers to take your place."

Philip's point was that, after receiving the Body of Christ, we become living tabernacles of God in a particularly special way. If ever there's ever a time to kneel and pray in thanksgiving, it's after receiving Holy Communion!

As you'll be pleased to hear, Philip's parishioner recognized his fault, asked for forgiveness and knelt before the altar in prayer.

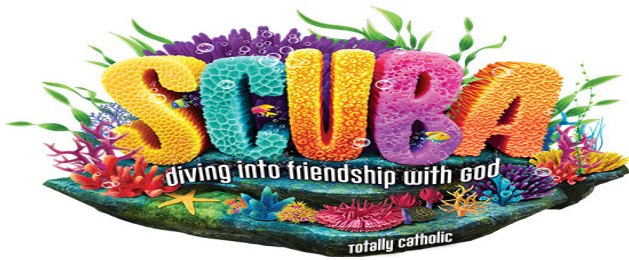

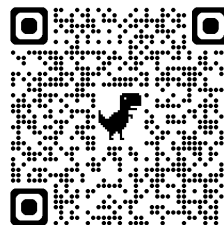

NOTA del PÁRROCO

¡Saludos en el Señor Jesucristo! Gracias a todos aquellos que pidieron aclaraciones en mis recientes Notas del Párroco. Respecto al pecado mortal en el boletín del 23 de junio, es necesario confesar los pecados mortales para poder recibir la absolución en el Sacramento de la Confesión. Si uno es consciente de un pecado mortal, pero decide no confesarlo, es posible que no sea absuelto incluso si el sacerdote dice la oración de absolución. Si uno tiene un gran temor de confesar un pecado mortal, entonces su culpabilidad podría disminuir. Por favor, sepan que los sacerdotes no están allí para juzgar a nadie. No queremos hacerle recordar los pecados a nadie. Sería como tratar de deleitarse con la basura de otras personas. Hay tantas cosas buenas que apreciar en las personas, ¿por qué querríamos centrarnos en su basura? Si uno tiene un pecado mortal que olvida confesar, pero recuerda más tarde, entonces debe confesarlo en su próxima confesión, pero queda absuelto de sus pecados en la confesión actual.

Y ya que hablamos de confesión, todos los católicos tenemos la obligación de confesarse al menos una vez al año. Hablando de una vez al año, los católicos sólo están obligados a recibir la comunión una vez al año, y eso sería durante la temporada de Pascua. Debemos ir a Misa todos los domingos (la vigilia del sábado cuenta. Y nuevamente, aquellos que no pueden físicamente, no tienen transporte, tienen que cuidar a un ser querido enfermo, etc., no tienen la obligación), pero no tenemos obligación de recibir la comunión en cada Misa.

Si alguien no puede asistir a la Misa dominical debido al trabajo o cosas similares, tal vez podría considerar ir a una Misa entre semana. Algunos encuentran una Misa el domingo por la noche en otro lugar. Algunos hispanos van a Misas en inglés y algunos no hispanos van a Misas en español incluso si no pueden entender el idioma.

Con respecto a la nota del boletín del 30 de junio sobre llegar tarde a Misa y no recibir la Comunión, no existe una regla estricta sobre lo que se considera "tarde a Misa". Para mí, personalmente, si por negligencia pierdo el "Confiteor" ("Yo confieso ante Dios Todopoderoso..."), entonces consideraría que llego tarde a Misa. Sin embargo, si me detiene un tren y el retraso no es negligencia, puedo recordar mis pecados y decir el acto de contrición mientras espero. Si me pierdo la primera lectura, igualmente asistiré, pero no recibiré. Aquellos con niños que no puedan encontrar sus zapatos podrían ser excusados. ¡El Señor es bondadoso y misericordioso!

Hay muchos que no comulgan en la Misa: los que aún no son católicos, los que aún no han recibido la Primera Comunión, los que están en pecado mortal. Siempre es digno de elogio ver en una Misa fúnebre a los no católicos que simplemente permanecen en sus bancos durante la comunión o hacen la señal de la cruz sobre sí mismos para señalar tranquilamente su respeto por la Eucaristía y recibir una bendición del sacerdote en su lugar.

Finalmente, la semana pasada di algunas preguntas para reflexionar sobre cuál es nuestra actitud hacia Dios en función de cómo nos vestimos en Misa, o si llegamos tarde por negligencia. Otra cosa que se me ocurrió es salir inmediatamente después de recibir la comunión (estarían exentos los que salen por motivos graves). ¿Tratamos la Eucaristía como una píldora mágica supersticiosa que creemos que funcionará si la recibimos y salimos directamente por la puerta? He aquí una historia sobre el humorístico San Felipe Neri del siglo XVI: Felipe se hizo sacerdote y, durante la Misa, notó que un miembro de su congregación siempre se marchaba inmediatamente después de recibir la Sagrada Comunión. Una vez, cuando el feligrés salía de la iglesia, Felipe envió dos monaguillos, ambos con velas, para seguir al hombre y escoltarlo por las calles. ¡Esto estuvo acompañado también, sin duda, por muchas risas y señalamientos por parte de quienes pasaban! Irritado, el hombre exigió saber por qué lo seguían los monaguillos. Dijeron que el Padre Neri les había ordenado que lo hicieran. Al oír esto, el hombre regresó a la iglesia y le preguntó al sacerdote por qué había hecho esto. San Felipe dijo: "Es para rendir el debido respeto a Nuestro Señor, a quien lleváis con vosotros.
