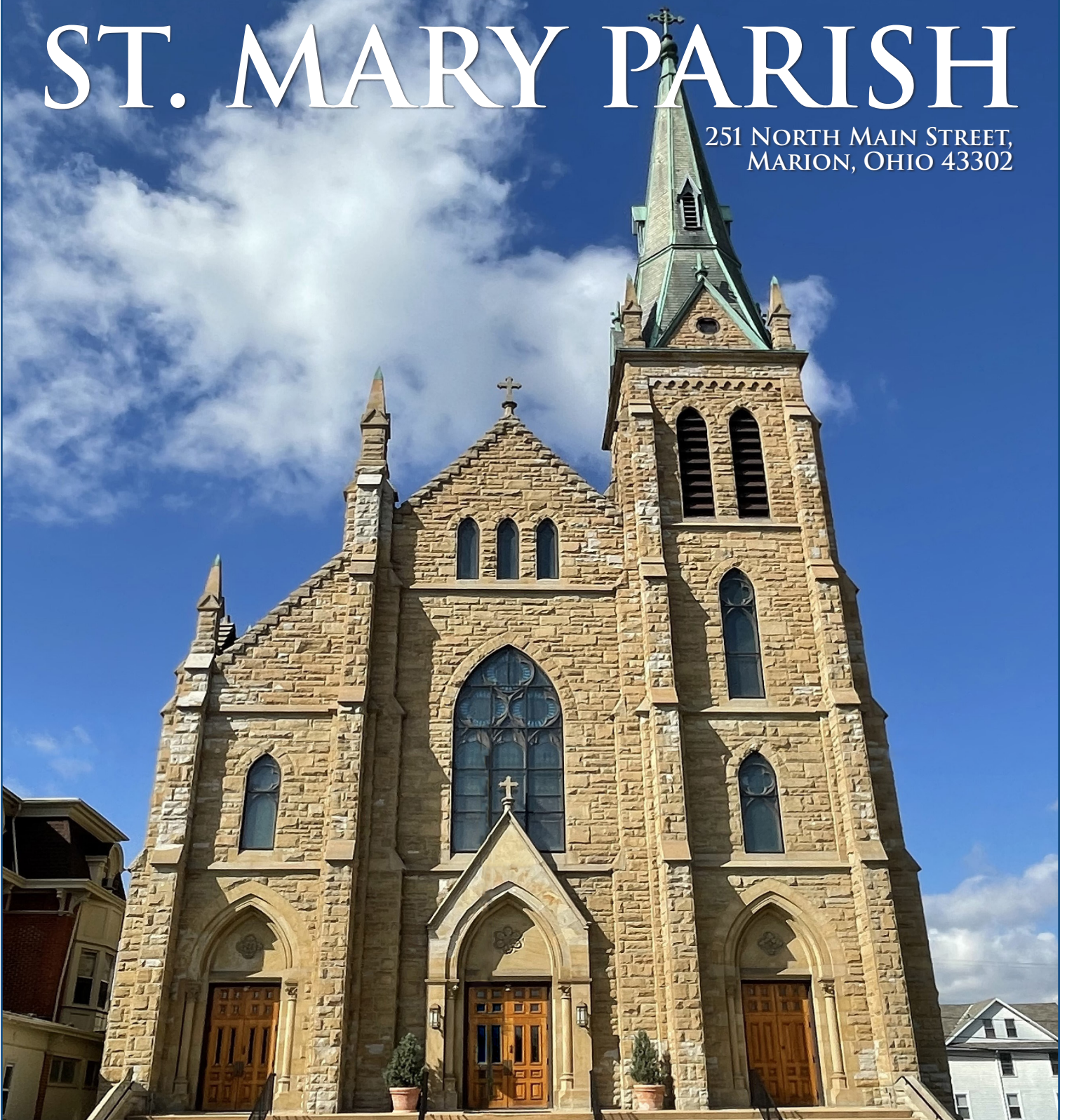

Greetings in the Lord, Jesus Christ! It is good to see people taking advantage of having Masses offered for their deceased loved ones. For those who do not know, the name "Holy Sacrifice of the Mass" refers to the sacrifice of Jesus on the cross which is offered to the Father in heaven. It does not mean that Jesus is being re-sacrificed, but His one sacrifice is offered again and again every time a Mass is celebrated, so each Mass has spiritual merit. Masses can even be offered for the living or for a special intention. To schedule a Mass intention, please call the office. The typical stipend of a Mass intention is \$10.00 which goes to the priest who celebrates that Mass. It can be more or less. There is no actual requirement.

Right now, St. Mary's Mass schedule is already full through the end of the year. Scheduling for the new year will begin in October. Sacred Hearts Church has a few openings before then, so you may call and schedule the Mass intentions there.

Another option to schedule a Mass intention is to go through the diocesan Missions Office. They receive requests from many priests who work in the missions around the world. Those priests often get very little pay because the impoverished area cannot afford to pay them a living wage. Mass stipends help with their living income. And since the people themselves are impoverished, most cannot afford to pay a stipend for a Mass, so the priest may not have any special intention or stipend for that Mass.

There is no way to arrange for a Mass for a specific date, but the Missions office says that Masses are celebrated as soon as possible after offerings are received. You can go to columbuscatholic.org/missions/request-a-mass to schedule a Mass intention that will be celebrated by a mission priest.

We have some improvement projects happening here at St. Mary's. As you know, in the last year, we've had big expense items such as the rebuilding of the Moira Hall north steps, the removal of carpet and restoring the hardwood floor in the church, and the steeple slate repair, just to name a few. Upcoming, we will have the entire south lot repaved, along with the alley between the church and school, and some of the north lot. All of this repaving will be about \$100,000. Then, I would like to have the Moira Hall bathrooms redone. We are working with an architect to redesign our bathrooms and all of that I'm sure will be another big expense. I make an appeal again, especially to those who do not yet contribute and are able to do so, to please make contributing to the parish a part of your spiritual responsibility. Supporting the needs of the parish is one of the precepts of the Church. Our church and buildings are a home and a place for people to come to worship God, to pray, and to have a faith community to support them, so we do need to keep them in good condition. I know there are a great many things in this world to contribute to, but I hope that you will consider the church a priority. Even those who are not Christians, those who are going through a difficult time in life love to come into the church to pray. They need us here. Thank you for your generosity!

Dear St. Mary Parishioners,

Having just ended the first half of our year on June 30, we would like to let you know where we stand. As of June 30, 2024, The Pantry served 5,280 people as opposed to 4,394 for the same period last year. This is an increase of 886 people or plus 20.2 % over last year.

The second half of the year is always busier so we anticipate serving between 14,000 and 15,000 people during the year. Considering that in 2022 we served 7,022 people and in 2023 we served 10,355 people, the need for assistance continues to grow.

You, as parishioners of St. Mary Church, make all the difference by your generous donations and your continued support of our mission here at St. Vincent de Paul Center.

We ask for your continued support and always welcome people interested in volunteering. The need for volunteers also continues to grow, so please let us know if you are interested.

COMUNIDAD HISPANA

Saludos en el Señor, Jesucristo! Es bueno ver a la gente aprovechando las Misas ofrecidas por sus seres queridos fallecidos. Para aquellos que no lo saben, el nombre "Santo Sacrificio de la Misa" se refiere al sacrificio de Jesús en la cruz que se ofrece al Padre en el cielo. No significa que Jesús esté siendo sacrificado nuevamente, sino que su único sacrificio se ofrece una y otra vez cada vez que se celebra una Misa, por lo que cada Misa tiene mérito espiritual. Las Misas incluso se pueden ofrecer por los vivos o por una intención especial. Para programar una intención de Misa, llame a la oficina. El estipendio típico de una intención de Misa es de \$10 que se destina al sacerdote que celebra esa Misa. Puede ser más o menos. No hay un requisito real.

En este momento, el calendario de misas de Santa María ya está completo hasta fin de año. La programación para el nuevo año comenzará en octubre. La Iglesia de los Sagrados Corazones tiene algunas vacantes antes de esa fecha, por lo que puede llamar y programar las intenciones de Misa allí.

Otra opción para programar una intención de Misa es pasar por la Oficina de Misiones de la Diócesis. Allí reciben solicitudes de muchos sacerdotes que trabajan en misiones en todo el mundo. Esos sacerdotes a menudo reciben muy poco dinero porque la zona empobrecida no puede permitirse pagarles un salario digno. Los estipendios de Misa ayudan con sus ingresos para vivir. Y como la gente misma es pobre, la mayoría no puede permitirse pagar un estipendio por una Misa, por lo que el sacerdote puede no tener ninguna intención especial o estipendio para esa Misa.

No hay forma de organizar una Misa para una fecha específica, pero la oficina de Misiones dice que las Misas se celebran lo antes posible después de recibir las ofrendas. Puede ir a columbuscatholic.org/missions/request-a-mass para programar una intención de Misa que será celebrada por un sacerdote de la misión.

Tenemos algunos proyectos de mejora en marcha aquí en St. Mary's. Como saben, el año pasado tuvimos gastos importantes, como la reconstrucción de los escalones norte de Moira Hall, la remoción de alfombras y la restauración del piso de madera de la iglesia, y la reparación de la losa del campanario, por nombrar solo algunos. Próximamente, repavimentaremos todo el lote sur, junto con el callejón entre la iglesia y la escuela, y parte del lote norte. Todo este trabajo de repavimentación costará alrededor de \$100,000. Luego, me gustaría que se rehicieran los baños de Moira Hall. Estamos trabajando con un arquitecto para rediseñar nuestros baños y estoy seguro de que todo eso será otro gasto importante. Hago un llamado nuevamente, especialmente a aquellos que aún no contribuyen y pueden hacerlo, para que por favor hagan de la contribución a la parroquia una parte de su responsabilidad espiritual. Apoyar las necesidades de la parroquia es uno de los preceptos de la Iglesia. Nuestra iglesia y nuestros edificios son un hogar y un lugar para que la gente venga a adorar a Dios, a orar y a tener una comunidad de fe que los apoye, por lo que debemos mantenerlos en buenas condiciones. Sé que hay muchas cosas en este mundo a las que podemos contribuir, pero espero que consideren a la iglesia como una prioridad. Incluso a quienes no son cristianos, a quienes están pasando por un momento difícil en la vida, les gusta venir a la iglesia a orar. Nos necesitan aquí. ¡Gracias por su generosidad!
